In total, 522 volunteers served 3,955 elementary students through a custom shoe fitting experience and the gift of a brand new pair of athletic shoes to get the school year started on the right foot. Attendees also had the opportunity to connect with 15 local organizations who engaged with families, offered great giveaways, and provided fun activities for students throughout the event.

The Program was hosted at DeVos Place, which allowed for growth in terms of the number served and the space available for the event. It also provided a more centralized location within Kent County to reach more students. With a larger space, In The Image was able to include other local organizations to setup tables throughout the week who could offer supportive services to students and families throughout the year. Of note, the Lions KidSight USA performed 1168 free vision screenings.
